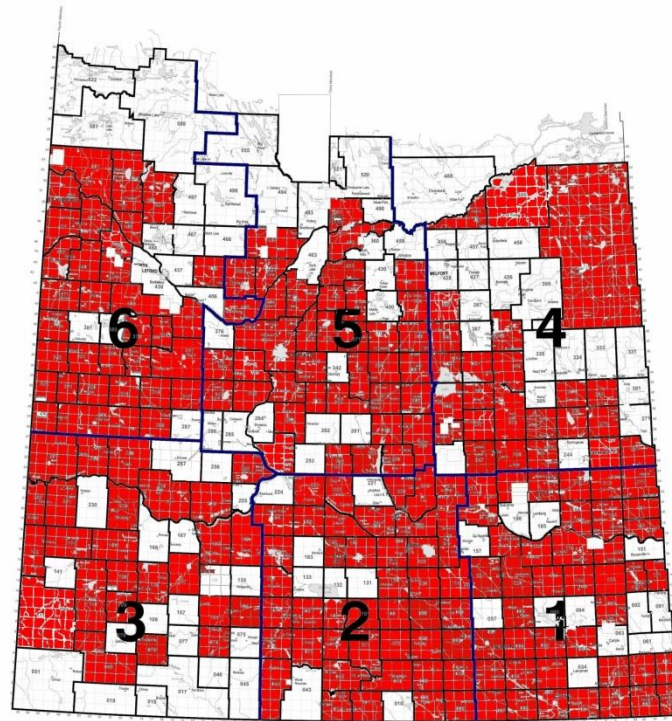

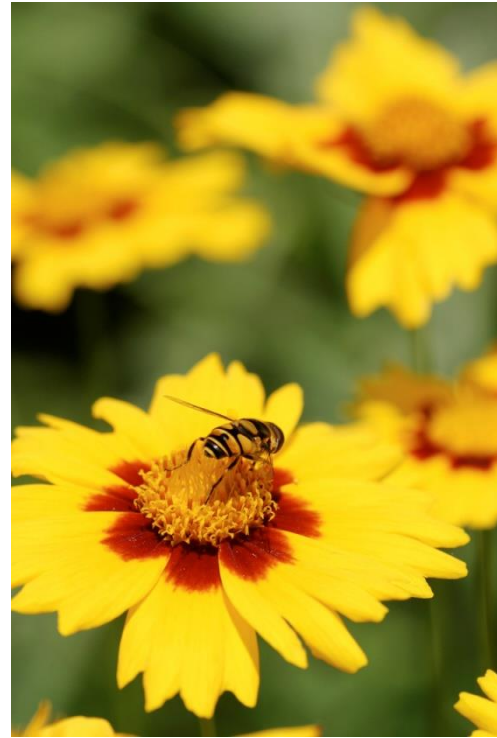

Current research findings indicate that farm families are at risk for the following reasons:

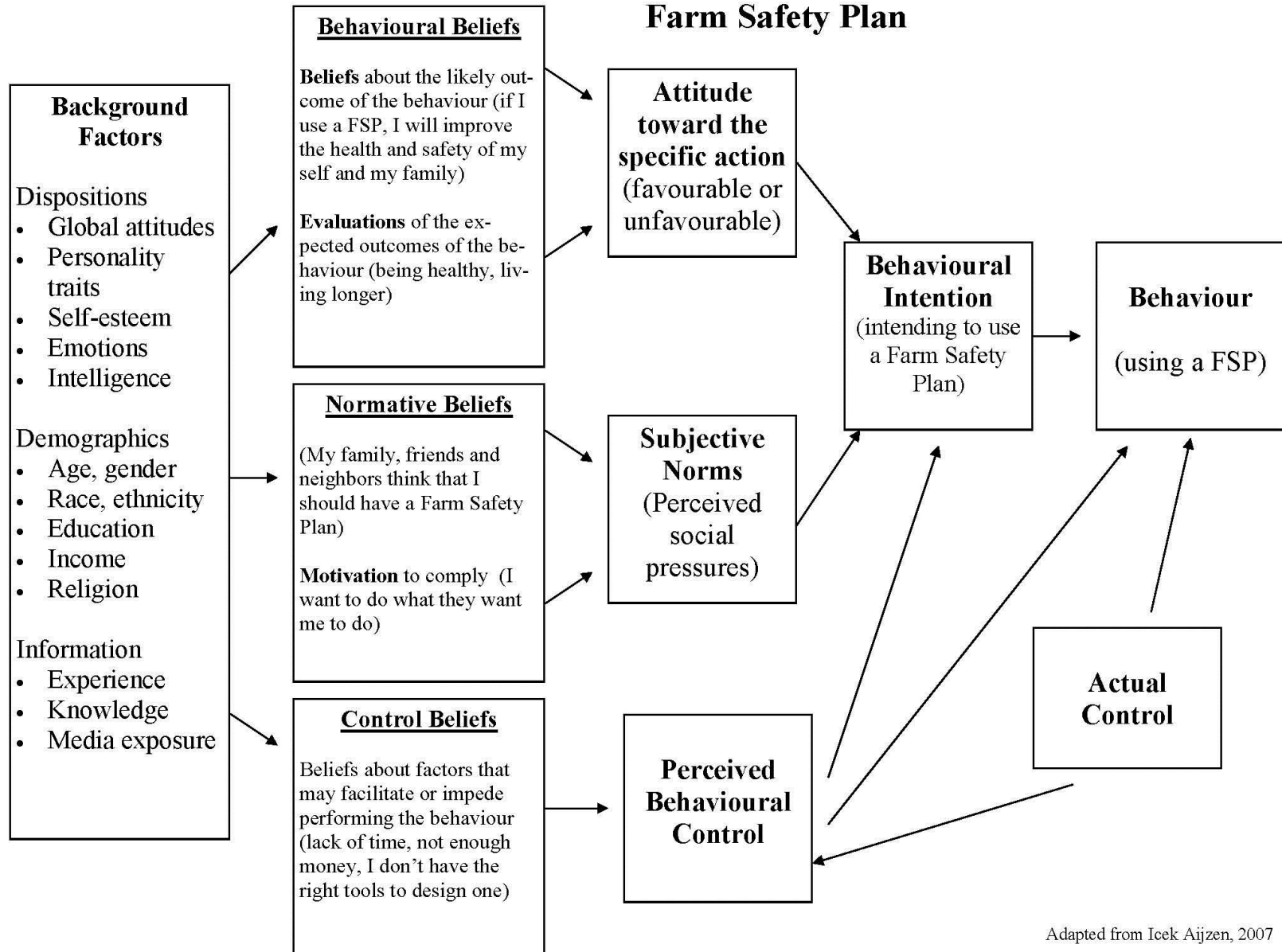
- Long work hours and fatigue
