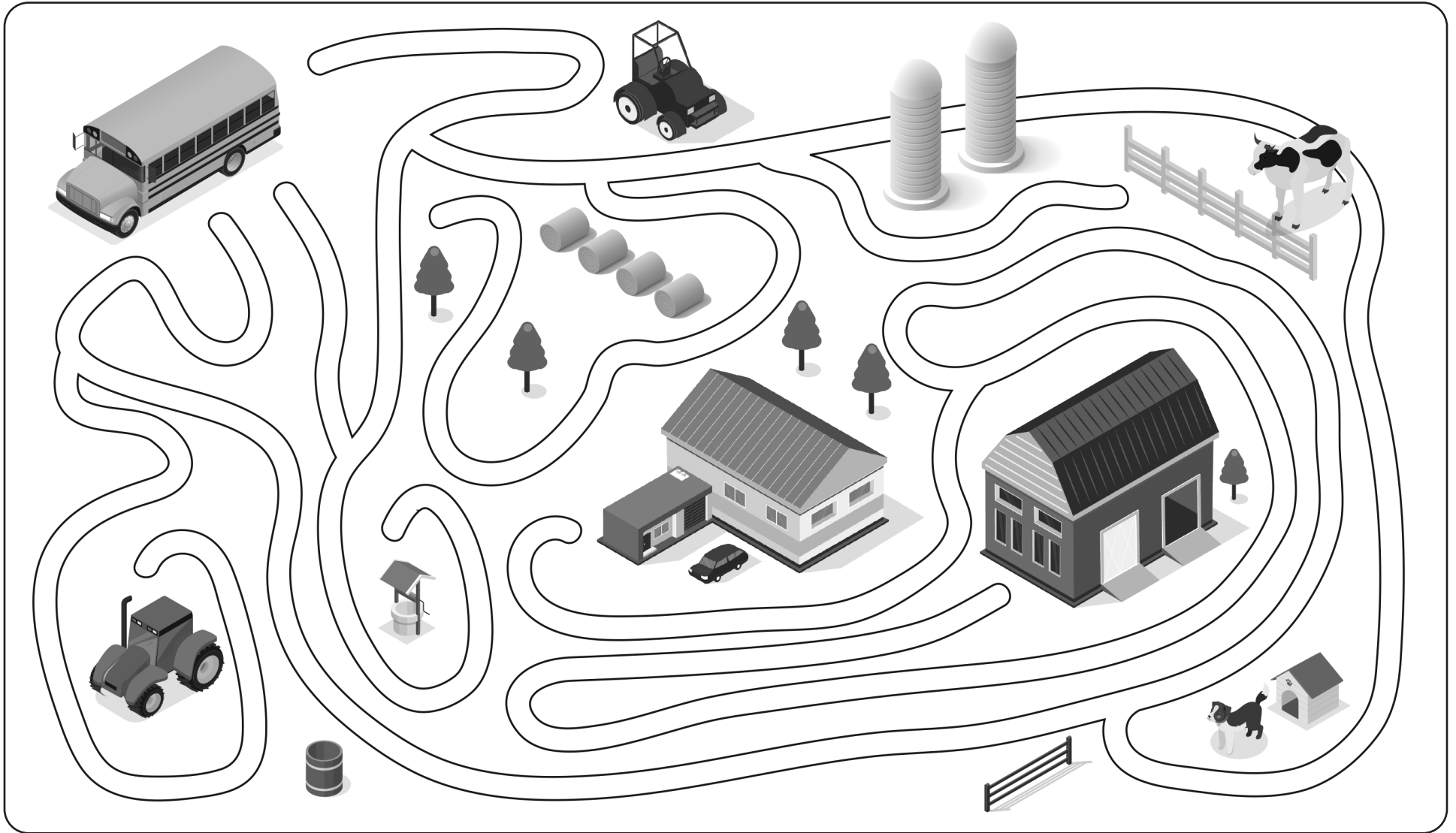

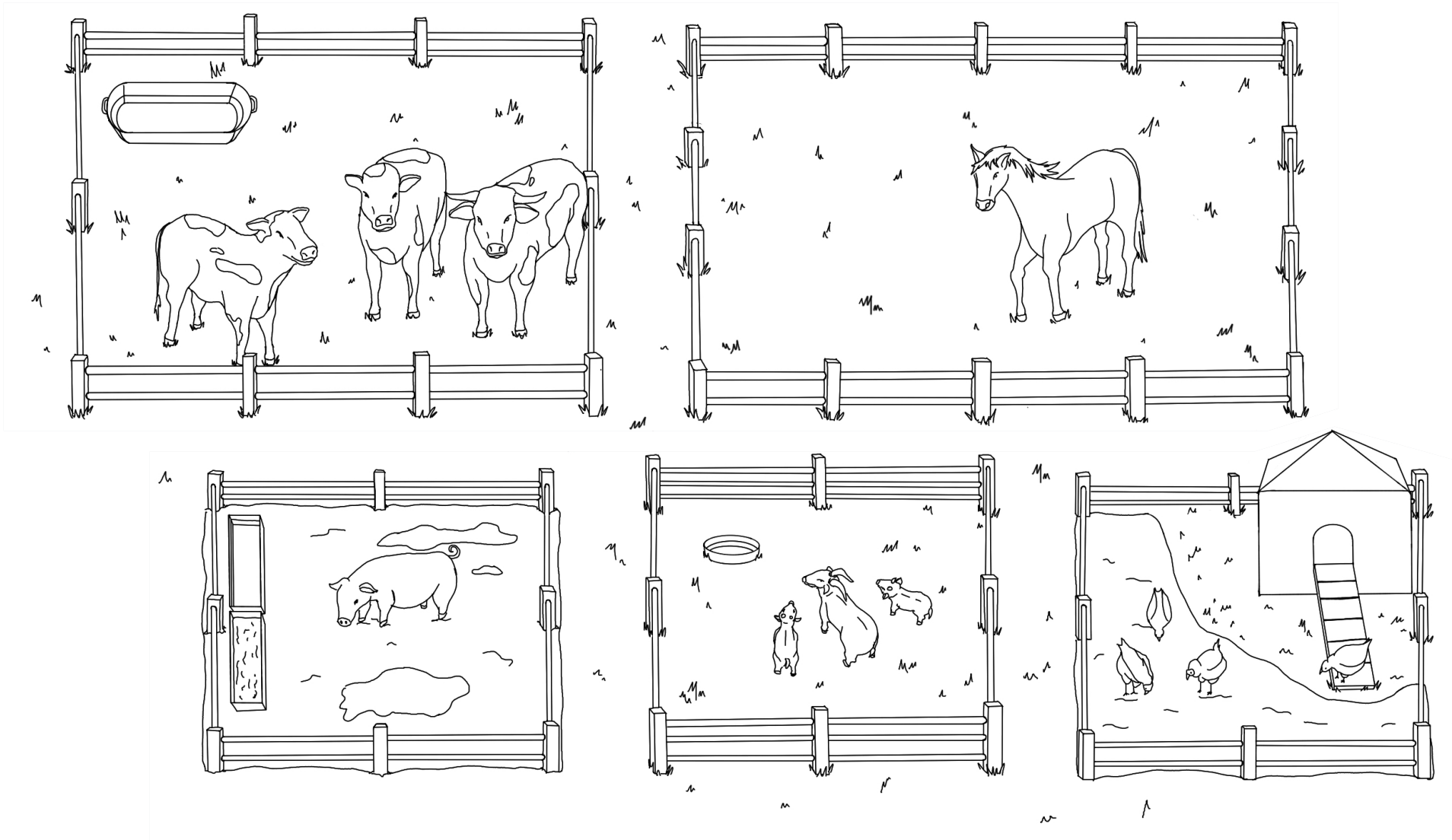
Head for the school bus and avoid the hazards around the farmyard.



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FARM ANIMAL SAFETY COLOURING PAGE



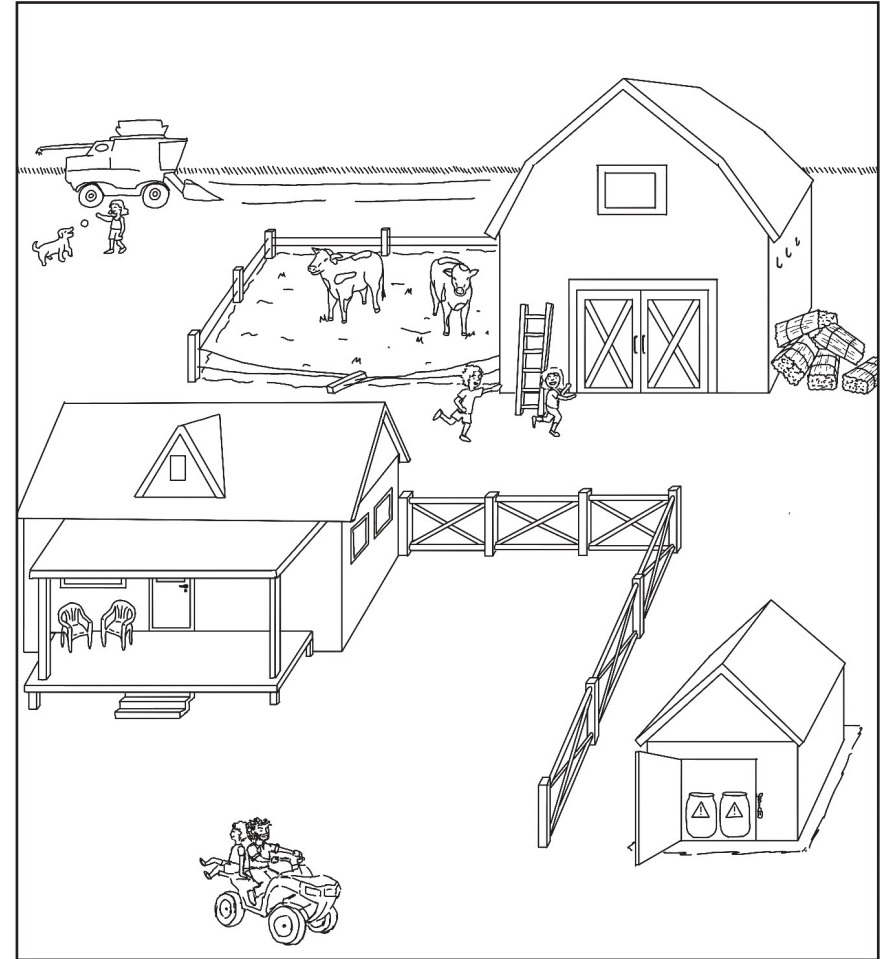
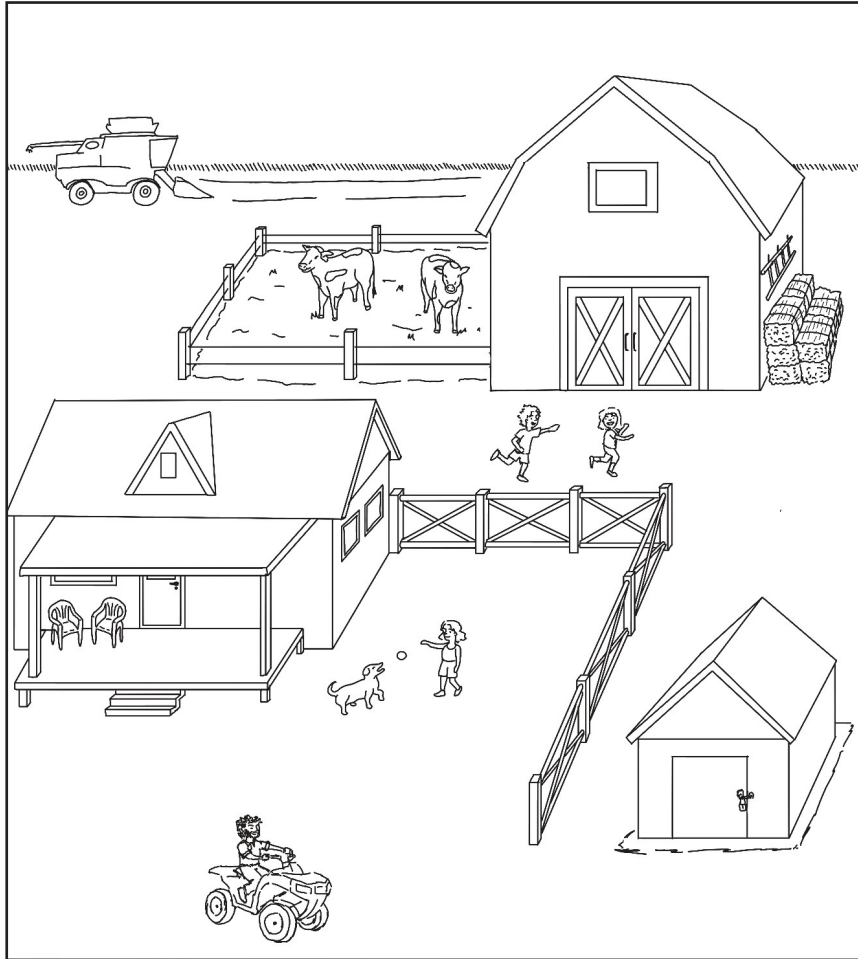
